PROGRAMS FOR TODDLERS

Toddler Music Classes

Little ones will have an opportunity to

participate in pitch and rhythm explorations, movement activities, musical games, instrument jam sessions, and sensory activities while addressing social

and academic skills. Each class is 45 minutes.

PROGRAMS FOR SCHOOLS

Introduction to Music Classes

Children ages 5+ will learn about the elements of music (melody, harmony, rhythm, timbre, expression, form, style, and context) while singing, moving, listening, reading, and creating music. (The National Standards for Music Education will be addressed).

Private/Group Music Lessons

Private piano and guitar lessons are designed

for children 4-17 and adults as an introduction to music fundamentals and keyboard skills. Students will participate in 30 minute, 45 minute, or 1 hour individual piano lessons once a week. Group lessons can also be scheduled. Max number of participants = 8.

After School Program Activities

This program is designed to offer students

participating in the after school program opportunities for artistic exploration and extended learning of their in-school arts curriculum. Activities may include ensemble work, instrument playing (i.e. drums, recorders, etc.), soundtracks & musicals, composing, musical games, intro to music theory and history, etc. Learning centers may choose to combine 2 or more Small Steps Music Programs to design the perfect after school program

for their participants.

Classroom/School Performances

Make special memories with your students and their families by having students become performers in a special musical performance! (great for the holidays and end of school)

OTHER OPPORTUNITIES

Teacher Consultations

A certified music educator will work with your teacher (s) to help them resolve music education related problems.

Consultations may also be used to explore ways to incorporate music in the classroom setting.

Staff Development Workshops/In-services

Workshops and In-services range from 45 minutes to 2+ hours. A certified music educator provides classroom teachers with information, strategies/techniques, and activity ideas that can easily be implemented in their lesson planning.

Summer Camp Music Enrichment Activities

Group music activities offered to enhance your students' summer fun. Age specific sessions designed for kids 2- 12 years old.

Music Therapy

Individual and group sessions that use musical interactions and interventions to help children and adults with special needs learn both functional and academic skills necessary to lead independent, fulfilling lives. A Board Certified Music Therapist will work with varying ages and abilities, including individuals with cerebral palsy, autism spectrum disorder, pervasive developmental disorders, and attention deficit/hyperactivity disorder.
